

Job Position: Fire Inspector

Job Location: Mercury, NV

The Nevada National Security Site, Fire & Rescue Department is currently seeking applications for the position of Fire Inspector. The following are some of the assigned duties:

- Plans, coordinates, and documents facility fire inspections for Life Safety Code compliance.
- Determines operability of fire protection systems and equipment during routine fire safety inspections i.e. detection systems, suppression systems, fire-rated doors, dampers, etc.
- Determines appropriate fire extinguisher types based on hazards present and determines its operability by visual inspection.
- Evaluates flammable/combustible liquids and hazardous materials storage and evaluates fire prevention practices.
- Reviews and analyzes fire protection system test data as performed by company organizations.
- Document, initiate, and track corrective actions as identified during the performance of these duties.
- Provide timely, cost effective, and innovative solutions to facility owners regarding complex fire protection issues.
- Develop, plan, coordinate, conduct, and document pre-fire incident plans.
- Advise management in determining compensatory measures during fire protection system impairments.
- Collect, evaluate, and disseminate scene information to the Incident Commander.
- If qualified, Fire Inspectors may be requested by Chief Officers to assist the Firefighters with operations such as offloading and/or retrieving suppression equipment and supplies, advancing hose line, and other suppression duties as directed by the Senior Fire Officer on scene.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

DOD, IFSAC or ProBoard certified as a Fire Inspector I, with a minimum of 5-7 years of fire prevention experience performing building fire inspections and Firefighter II certification. ICS-100, 200, 300, and 700. EMT Basic preferred, but not required. This is a collective-bargaining agreement position on a 4 day – 10 hour schedule.
