General Accountability:

Under the supervision of the Chief Fire Inspector / Deputy Fire Chief conducts daily duties as primary duties. Secondary duty must be able to operate all Fire apparatus and conduct fire operations on Structural and ARFF.

Structure:

Under the supervision of the Chief Fire Inspector conducts daily duties. Inspects existing structures, construction and remodeled sites for compliance with fire codes

Dimensions:

- As a Fire Inspector you are to ensure that full compliance is maintained IAW the contracted levels.
- Shall inspect existing structures, construction and remodelled sites for compliance with fire safety codes.
- Resolves regulatory compliance problems with owners within scope of knowledge and authority having jurisdiction.
- Take part in the fire investigation of fire incidents or where ever direct by CFI or Senior Officer
- Provide public education in fire prevention, including giving talks, demonstrations, and presentations before military, civil contractor, and other organizations or institutions.
- Shall be able to prepare reports concerning the fire services; participate in the inspection, testing and maintenance of fixed and portable fire extinguishing systems, water distribution systems and all other equipment related to the fire services.
- Participates in the inspection of, fire hydrants, sprinkling systems, and elements of a fire prevention or protection system.
- Review and approve construction plans for code compliance.
- Respond to complaints regarding fire code violations and fire hazards. Issue warnings and citations for fire code violations.
- Maintains a variety of data and records regarding fire inspection or prevention activities; prepares reports regarding fire inspection or prevention as required.
- Assists in other department administrative activities as assigned.

- Shall have the ability to instruct classes in assigned subject areas.
- Assist in training new employees as assigned.
- When required shall participate in fire fighting operations, rescue operations, fire fighting training activities

Specific Accountabilities:

1. Shall be conducting fire inspections and education training sections
 - a. Assist the CFI in the development of FR fire safety program's and SOP's
 - b. Taking action as required by SOP's;
 - c. Comply with FR FD policy;
 - d. Perform in a professional manner that prevents damage, loss or unnecessary financial loss to Fire Department equipment and materials;
 - e. Accepting responsibility for errors or personal shortcomings and be able to accept constructive criticism and correct downfalls; and
 - f. Become familiar with COMKAF safety regulations, in particular the safety regulations which pertain to the FR FD and operations.
 - g. Perform various other duties as assigned
2. Shall participate in fire fighting and rescue operations by:
 - a. Removing personnel from an area of high risk to an area of relative safety;
 - b. Executing fire extinguishing procedures;
 - c. Providing Advance First Aid & CPR to the injured;
 - d. Returning equipment to a state of normal stand-by readiness after every use; and
 - e. Operating Firefighting rescue tools (manual & power) and portable pumps.
3. Shall participate in required fire fighting training activities.
4. Shall maintain a physical fitness standard as required by FR FD policy.
5. Participates in the inspection, testing and maintenance of all fixed or portable Extinguishing or detection systems, fire apparatus and water distribution systems by:
6. Maintains a high level of cooperation between peers, subordinates and supervisors by;

Educational & Experience Requirements:

Must have at least 5 Years minimum experience on an Operational Fire Department as a Fire Inspector/Fire Prevention Officer.
